TOPIC -----

I'm testing Wollongong's PathWay NFS client product for Macintosh OS with my TCP-accessible A/UX host. The Wollongong documents refer to nfsad (NFS Authentication Daemon), which must be installed on the nfs server. Does A/UX support nfsad?

DISCUSSION -----

A/UX 3.0 supports the improved version of NFS, which is NFS SRC 3.0 and version 2 of the protocol from Sun Microsystems. NFS SRC 3.0 and protocol version 2.0 do support the authentication check. However, the "nfsad" daemon mentioned in Wollongong documents isn't part of the A/UX NFS programs. We don't know why Wollongong PathWay NFS clients need "nfsad" installed on the NFS server.
