Can I use any box? DISCUSSION -----There are no shipping requirements for keyboards. Basically, it's okay to put a product into any box that fits as long as it's sufficently protected from ESD and shipping damage. Hard drives are particularly susceptible to damage in shipping and should be returned in appropriate packaging whenever possible.
