ADB Keyboards: Replace Keyswitches with Same Color

TOPIC -----

Apple has three different ADB keyswitch sets: orange, tan, and white plungers. I have a set of 076-0209, now called "Tan Plunger", except that it looks more orange than tan. I almost had to replace what SEEMED to be a white one in an Extended Keyboard II today. It appeared identical to my orange one in form, fit, and function.

DISCUSSION -----

Several vendors supply Apple with keyboards. Although they may fit your keyboard correctly, there may be differences in the keyswitch that will prevent it from working correctly in a keyboard with the tan plungers.
