A/UX: Doesn't Support TCP/IP on Token-Ring (9/94)

TOPIC -----

Can A/UX 3.0 implement TCP/IP on a Token-Ring network? Does any third-party developer offer a device driver for A/UX?

DISCUSSION -----

Because no drivers exist for the 4/16 Token Ring NB card under A/UX, A/UX doesn't support TCP/IP via Token Ring. A/UX only supports Ethernet and Serial (SLIP).

There are several third-party KIP-compatible routers that support routing among LocalTalk LANs and a Token Ring (IEEE 802.5) LAN, but nothing that will allow direct token ring connection of an A/UX workstation.
