Apple TechStep

Apple TechStep is a portable test tool that lets Authorized Apple Service Providers troubleshoot Macintosh systems and peripherals more quickly, thoroughly, and accurately than ever before. Because it is small and lightweight, it is perfect for on-site or in-house repairs.

Apple TechStep features include:

- The ability to test non-bootable systems.
- A fast and accurate way to test SIMMs.
- The ability to detect intermittent failures through looping tests.
- The ability to thoroughly test systems including logic boards, hard drives, floppy drives, and video cards.
