AppleTalk Remote Access: Create Custom Script to Use Racal Modem

TOPIC -----

We'd like to use AppleTalk Remote Access with a Racal 9600 Modem (Model #RMD3222). Do you know if there's a modem script available for this modem? If not, how can we use this modem?

DISCUSSION -----

Unfortunately, we aren't aware of any scripts specifically designed for the Racal modem.

It would be possible for you to create a "custom" script for the modem.

The AppleTalk Remote Access Modem Toolkit, available from APDA, contains a script writing guide and a Modem Workshop HyperCard stack that you can use to create, modify, and test modem scripts.
