

## AppleCD SC Plus, AppleCD 150: Different Drive Mechanism Designs

TOPIC -----

In the Technical Procedures, Cross Family Peripherals, AppleCD SC/CD SC Plus/CD 150 section, page 6.2, the introduction paragraph states:

"... the AppleCD 150 contains the same SCSI CD-ROM drive mechanism as the AppleCD SC Plus ..."

Is this correct?

DISCUSSION -----

The two CD mechanisms have the same access time, and so on; however, the drive mechanism designs are different. The AppleCD 150 printed circuit board and headphone board are in different locations on the drive. This change (streamlining) was done to allow the AppleCD 150 to be put into a smaller box. Sony has different part numbers for each mechanism, and they are not interchangeable.

The AppleCD 150 current repair strategy is a "whole unit" exchange. Service Providers should not use an AppleCD SC Plus drive mechanism to repair an AppleCD 150.
