Apple Workgroup Server 95: E-Mail Server (9/93)

TOPIC -----

Will the Apple Workgroup Server (AWS) 95 support E-Mail packages like QuickMail and MS Mail? Will it handle mail gateways for QuickMail or MS Mail to other mail systems? What are the performance consequences of using it as a mail server for 50 concurrent mail users logged on as well as 50 concurrent file server users logged on?

DISCUSSION -----

We have heard that the QuickMail server does not run properly on the AWS 95, but that the MS Mail server does (unverified). The gateways may be the same. You may want to check with the specific vendors of the gateways before you recommend their use. To locate a vendor's address and phone number, use the vendor name as a search string.

There have been no specific performance studies done comparing the performance of running the server as an file server alone verses running it in conjunction with a mail server. There is no question that you can expect degradation in performance, how much is dependent on how the services of the server are used. The benchmarks we have done comparing the file server and Oracle running concurrently, show as much as a 60% drop in performance. We don't expect MS Mail to reduce disk performance as much as Oracle, but that really depends on the customers usage.
