Apple Color Plus: Border and Image Sizes (4/94)

TOPIC -----

Customers have been complaining that the border on the Apple Color Plus is too large. The borders on the Apple Color Plus that we have in our lab also has large borders consisting of about .5 inch right and left and about .25 top and bottom. What should the image size on this monitor be?

DISCUSSION -----

The active raster width for the Apple Color Plus display is approximately 9.4 inches, which is just slightly more than the Macintosh Color Display (9.25-in). The active raster vertical height is 7-in.
