Apple Color Plus Display: Shutdown When Sync Is Lost (10/94)

TOPIC -----

I have an Apple Color Plus Display that turns off when I turn off when my Macintosh Quadra 605 is shutdown, yet I haven't turned the monitor off. Why is this happening?

DISCUSSION -----

There are two different versions of the Apple Color Plus Display. The newer version of the Apple Color Plus Display has an energy saver mode that starts up when the sync signals are lost. The older version of the Apple Color Plus Display does not have this feature and stays powered on when the computer is shutoff.

All Apple Color Plus Displays beginning with the serial number sequence of CY344xxxx are energy saver models. The '3' represents 1993 and the 44 signifies week 44 of that year.
