TOPIC -----

When will a new edition of the System Software Restoration CD be available? The current CD does not work with the Power Macintosh computers using the PowerPC Enabler 1.1.1.

DISCUSSION -----

We have escalated your issue on the impact to the PowerPC Enabler 1.1.1 dependent computers.

As a work around, you can start the Power Macintosh computer requiring the PowerPC Enabler 1.1.1, by creating the Disk Tools disk from the Power Macintosh 8100/100 or Power Macintosh 8100/110 Install Me First CD. This floppy disk contains a bootable system with the PowerPC Enabler 1.1.1 and a CD-ROM Driver. Start from this floppy disk, and you will then be able to mount the Restoration CD and perform the Restore functions.
