TOPIC -----

Can I use program linking on an Apple Remote Access (ARA) MultiPort Server? What application should I use?

DISCUSSION -----

Yes, either AppleShare Admin 3.x, or 4.x can be used to enable program linking although neither one has been tested or supported for this purpose.

In order to run AppleShare Admin 4.x you will need an AppleShare 4.x serial number, and to obtain one, you must purchase AppleShare 4.x.

If cost is an issue, you could use AppleShare Admin 3.x to manage the program linking on an ARA MultiPort Server. Since Admin 3.x does not have serial number protection, this offers a solution that will let you take advantage of program linking on a ARA MultiPort server without having to have an AppleShare serial number. (Note for Apple support providers: It is OK to give a customer AppleShare Admin 3.x ONLY, do not give them the other files needed to run AppleShare.)

NOTE: Neither AppleShare Admin 4.x, or AppleShare Admin 3.x is officially supported so you use it at your own risk. The risk, however, should be minimal.
