DISCUSSION -----

The 1GB IBM HDA SCSI ID settings are detailed below. The connection is located on the bottom side of the drive, just opposite of the Power Connector. Jumper 1 will be located next to the inside corner of the board.

- Jumper 4: Disable Auto Spin up
- Jumper 5: Disable Unit Attention
- Jumper 6: Enable Termination
- Jumper 7: Disable TI Negotiation
