At Ease 3.0: Start-up Items Will Not Launch (6/95)

TOPIC -----

With At Ease 3.0, the items in my Startup Items folder do not launch when I startup my machine. The error "The application program 'xx' could not be opened, because you do not have enough access privileges" is displayed. Why is this occurring?

DISCUSSION -----

This problem occurs because At Ease 3.0 could not locate the "Shutdown Items" folder (not the "Startup Items" folder). If At Ease 3.0 cannot find the "Shutdown Items" folder, the items in the "Startup Items" folder do not get added to the approved list for items to launch, and thus you get the "you do not have enough access privileges" message. This problem will occur with System Software 7.0.x, 7.1.x, as well as with System Software 7.5.x if you do a "Custom Install" that does not include the AppleScript module.

With System Software 7.5.x you can work around this problem by doing a full installation. This can be done either by doing the "Easy Install", or by doing a "Custom Install" and installing AppleScript. Another option is to create a folder named "Shutdown Items" in your "System Folder". Other than adding the Startup application from the Startup Items folder to the application panel of the given setup, there is no real workaround for System Software 7.0.x or 7.1.x.
