## AppleVision 1710AV: Don't Mix Video Parameter Files (8/96)

TOPIC -----

I downloaded the video parameters settings from one AppleVision 1710AV display to another, now I cannot adjust the monitor so that it is within acceptable tolerances. Why?

DISCUSSION -----

Both video board and CRT for the AppleVision 1710 are factory configured for optimal video resolution and performance. Because of the way the video board and CRT are matched, you should never download video parameter settings from one AppleVision 1710 Display to another. As you have seen, when you mix video parameter settings from one display to another, the result can be a video signal that is so far out of tolerance, that it cannot be adjusted properly.
