

AOL 3.0 and AICK 1.1.x Registration Issue (2/97)

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TOPIC -----

This article provides a workaround for users who install America Online (AOL) 3.0 and cannot get the Apple Internet Connection Kit (AICK) 1.1.x registration process to work.

DISCUSSION -----

This issue applies to users who install AOL 3.0 before or after AICK 1.1.x. When users then register with an Internet service provider (ISP) they get the following message when Netscape launches:

"An error occurred during registration. Your customer information has not been used. Press 'Register' to attempt registration again"

When the user clicks OK in the error dialog, Netscape automatically quits, and the Dialer comes up again. This issue does not affect users who already have an ISP.

Explanation

AOL version 3.0 installs ObjectSupportLib version 1.1.1 which is incompatible with AICK 1.1.x.

The AICK installer seeing a newer version of the ObjectSupportLib than its own, which is version 1.0.2, leaves the newer one. So the ObjectSupportLibrary must be replaced by hand.

AICK version 1.2 works with version 1.1.1 of the library so it should not be affected by this issue.

Workaround

Step 1 Set Virtual Memory and the Extensions Manager appropriately.

Step 2 Put the AICK 1.1 CD-ROM disc in the CD-ROM drive. Step 3 Double click the hard disk; double click the System Folder. Step 4 Throw the MacTCP DNR file in the Trash Step 5 Double click the Extensions folder Step 6 Throw the ObjectSupportLib file in the Trash Step 7 Move the AOLink file from the Extensions folder (AOLink can be place in the AOL folder or elsewhere). AOLink lets America Online Software interface with Netscape and other Internet programs. It also interferes with the operation of AICK. Removing AOLink does not affect the performance of the AOL application itself, and its removal is necessary for AICK to operate. Step 8 Double click the AICK 1.1 CD icon; double click System Folder Items; double click Apple Guide. Look in the Apple Guide folder for the ObjectSupportLib extension. Move the ObjectSupportLib extension to the Extensions folder. Step 9 Go to the System Folder and double click the Preferences folder Step 10 Throw the MacTCP Prep, PPP Preferences, Internet Dialer Folder, Internet Preferences, and TCP/IP preferences files in the Trash Step 11 Launch the America Online application. Choose Preferences from the Members menu, and scroll down through the list and click once on AOL Link. Deselect the Auto Configuration checkbox. Quit America Online. (This is important to let the AOL application work properly.) Step 12 Restart Step 13 Launch AICK and proceed normally with the registration process.
