Color OneScanner: Use Custom Install with Power Macintosh (4/94)

TOPIC -----

When I try to perform an Easy Install of the Color OneScanner software on my Power Macintosh 6100/60. The installation fails trying to install QuickTime. Why?

DISCUSSION -----

The Color OneScanner disks contain QuickTime 1.5 which is not compatible with the Power Macintosh computers. However, there are ways to install the Color OneScanner software on a Power Macintosh computer.

- The best choice is to avoid installing QuickTime 1.5 by choosing "Custom Install".
- The Easy Install can be used, but QuickTime 1.6.2 needs to be removed from the System Folder and replaced once installation has been completed.
- The Easy Install can be used if the software is installed with extensions turned off. But QuickTime 1.5 needs to be replaced with version 1.6.2 found on the Power Macintosh CD or floppy disks if done this way.
