Color OneScanner: Use Custom Install on Macintosh 630 (8/95)

TOPIC -----

When I try to perform an Easy Install of the Color OneScanner software on a Macintosh 630 family computer, it tries to install a version of QuickTime that will not work with that Macintosh. Why?

DISCUSSION -----

The Color OneScanner disks contain QuickTime 1.5, which is not compatible with the Macintosh 630 family computers. However, there are ways to install the Color OneScanner software on Macintosh 630 family computers.

- The best choice is to avoid installing QuickTime 1.5 by choosing "Custom Install". This should leave the old version of QuickTime in your current System Folder.
- The Easy Install can be used, but QuickTime 1.6.2 (or 2.0) needs to be removed from the System Folder, and replaced once installation has been completed.
- The Easy Install can be used, if the software is installed with extensions turned off. But QuickTime 1.5 needs to be replaced with version 1.6.2 (or 2.0) found on the CD-ROM or floppy disks that came with your Macintosh 630 family computer.

The following computers are in the Macintosh 630 family: Performa 630, Performa 635, Performa 636, Performa 637, Performa 638, LC 630, and Quadra 630.
