## Color OneScanner: Visual Difference in Main Logic Board (9/95)

TOPIC -----

Is there a way to visually tell the difference between the REV A and REV B main logic board for the Color OneScanner?

DISCUSSION -----

The differences are slight but there are a few things that will help identify the correct board.

- Screw holes are different.  
On the Rev A version the screw holes are completely sealed and the Rev B version has the screw holes opened up where the main logic board is visible.
- Metal Casing different.  
The metal casing around the logic board has a dull finish on the Rev A version, whereas the Rev B. version is very shinny.
