TOPIC -----

There have been several questions about the Macintosh Display Card  $8 \cdot 24$  with respect to some incompatibility between the new card and the old ones. Several people have stated that the Adobe Type Manager does not work on the Macintosh Display Card  $8 \cdot 24$ .

Is it a temporary problem, or will Adobe have to rewrite their application?

DISCUSSION -----

We talked to Adobe Technical Support. They told us that the Adobe Type Manager and the Macintosh Display Card  $8 \cdot 24$  work fine together, as long as the following criteria are met:

- System Software 6.0.5 is installed
- 32-bit QuickDraw is installed
- Adobe Type Manager 1.2 is installed.
