## Disk II Controller Card: Connecting to an Apple 5.25-inch Drive

TOPIC -----

If I have a Apple IIe with the older-style 5.25-inch controller card (the card that has the two banks of pins connecting a ribbon cable to the old style 5.25-inch drive) is it possible to connect a newer Apple 5.25-inch drive?

I understand that this is not a standard solution, but is there some sort of cable interface I can make to do this?

DISCUSSION -----

There is a way to get the drive to function from the Disk II controller card, however it is not supported and will not comply with FCC regulations. It could cause electrical interference in the area. The way to connect it is to use the Disk II cable. This is a one-to-one-type connection.
