Is there a DAL Server for Oracle running on AIX?

DISCUSSION -----

Pacer Software has licensed DAL from Apple and has been working on DAL Servers for UNIX platforms, such as for SunOS, HP/UX, DEC Ultrix, and IBM RS/6000 AIX. The RS/6000 product was to be released during first calendar quarter of 1992. We don't know which database they support. Please contact Pacer Software directly for more information.

Most of the query tools that support DAL (like ClearAccess, DataPrism, and GQL) also support SQL*NET, Oracle's proprietary protocol for database access. So, if you're only planning to access Oracle, you don't necessarily need DAL on AIX to get the functionality you're looking for.
