TOPIC -----

- 1) On the IBM host we have an ACC box that provides a TCP/IP Ethernet connection to the mainframe. Is there some way we can get from a Macintosh on Ethernet using DAL to access DB2 data on the host (assuming we'd be running DAL/VTAM on the host) with this connection? Or are we limited to the 3270 datastream API support (we have Tri-Data Netway gateways for host access)?
- 2) Does DAL support the latest Tri-Data Netway software (Netway 3270 A/G 1.0)?

DISCUSSION -----

- 1) You must access the DB2 database via the Netway connection. DAL supports TCP/IP to VM hosts only.
 - 2) Yes, DAL supports Netway 3270 A/G 1.0.
