Disklock 2.1.2: Compatible with 68040 CPUs (10/93)

TOPIC -----

If you use DiskLock from Fifth Generation to password-protect drives and folders, be sure to use version 2.1.2 on 68040 CPUs. Version 2.1 is incompatible with 68040 CPUs with cache turned on.

DISCUSSION -----

Fix for the Macintosh:

- Restart a Quadra 840AV using the 840AV Install CD, forcing it to boot using Shift-Command-Option-Delete. (The internal drive won't be visible.)
- Find Cache Switch, and set for More Compatible.
- Restart again from Install CD. (The internal drive still isn't visible.)
- Launch the Emergency Unlock application from the Disklock disk. This makes the internal drive visible on the desktop.
- Launch HDSC Setup, and update the drivers on the internal drive.

Fix for DiskLock:

- Download Disklock 2.1.2 Update from AppleLink under Software/Third Party.
- Update Disklock 2.1 following instructions.
