The Desktop Printer software 1.0.1 that ships with the Color LaserWriter 12/600 PS, LaserWriter 4/600 PS, and Color StyleWriter 2200/2400 conflicts with PowerTalk. The problem we are experiencing is our system locks up after reboot. The problem occurs only when we have System 7.5 or 7.5.1, PowerTalk 1.1, and the Desktop Printing software installed together.

DISCUSSION -----

There is a known problem with the Desktop Printer Spooler extension v1.0.1 that causes the computer to hang or crash with the combination of software you are using. A newer version of the Desktop Printer Spooler (v1.0.2) resolves this issue and can be found on AppleLink in Software Sampler.
