I am using Display Service Utility v2.0 to adjust the video on a Power Macintosh 5200/75 LC computer. Every time I use the video display patterns, the computer freezes on a blue screen.

DISCUSSION -----

This is often caused by virtual memory being turned on. Make sure virtual memory is off in the Memory control panel before you open the Display Service Utility.
