

Focus TurboStar: Fix Avaliable for LocalTalk Problem (1/95)

TOPIC -----

A few months ago I was made aware of a problem with LocalTalk performance on a Power Macintosh 7100. It turned out the customer was using a Focus TurboStar, which has a LocalTalk chip that doesn't exactly meet the tight specifications of the Power Macintosh computers. The interim software fix was to install NSI 1.4.3.

The customer has recently upgraded to System 7.5, and reports this fix does not work. Are there any other workarounds? Or should I recommend that the customer stick with 7.1.2 until the hardware fix is available?
