TOPIC -----

The color ribbon was not working properly on my ImageWriter II so I replaced the Drive PCB which fixed that problem. However, it now has an electronic hiss coming from the Drive PCB area. This unit also has an AppleTalk option card installed.

What could be causing the problem (bad printhead, motor assembly for the color ribbon, main logic board)?

DISCUSSION -----

The noise could be generated by a component on the Drive PCB with a mild short. The unit may have problems, especially if it is moved causing the short to increase. The only solution is to replace the Drive PCB.
