DISCUSSION -----

From the LaserWriter II Service manual:

| Material Name | Use | Purchase | Remarks |
|---------------------------------|--|---------------------------------------|---|
| Alcohol | Cleaning: Glass, Rubber, External Covers | Locally | All are flammable. Use in well-ventilated area. Avoid breathing concentrated vapor. |
| MEK (Methyl ethyl ketone) | Cleaning: Metal, Oil, and Toner Stains | Locally | Very flammable. Do not use for cleaning the drum, molded-plastic parts, or corona wires. Use in well-ventilated area. Avoid contact with eyes and excessive contact with skin. |
| Heat-Resistant Grease | Apply to Drive Mechanism | HITASOL MO 138S | This grease has highly superior load resistance, heat resistance, and anti-friction property. Gray color grease, 30 wt. Heat-resistant to 300C. |
| Lubricating Oil | Bearings | ISO VG 68 Oil, Mobil Vactra Oil | Equivalent oil may be used. |
