## LaserWriter IINT: Troubleshooting Font Problem

### TOPIC -----

A customer reported problems printing PageMaker 4.0 files containing Illustrator 4.0 graphics on one of his two LaserWriter IINT printers. Sometimes fonts are substituted, and in other cases, some fonts aren't printed at all. He doesn't have this problem with his other LaserWriter IINT.

Before I look for a hardware problem, I'd like to check if there are any known compatibility problems with PageMaker 4.0 or Illustrator 4.0 and the LaserWriter IINT printers.

### DISCUSSION -----

We don't know of any compatibility problems between the software you mention and the LaserWriter IINT.

Since the customer's other LaserWriter IINT prints these files OK, the problem is most likely hardware. We suggest that you first try swapping the I/O boards between the two printers. If the problem follows the I/O board, chances are fairly high that you have a failed board that needs to be replaced.

If the problem doesn't follow the I/O board, check the DC Controller next. This may be causing the problem, although this is not likely.
