Can the North American LaserWriter II be converted to 220v for European operation?

DISCUSSION -----

Section 6.12 in the LaserWriter II technical procedures (under the additional procedures tab) describes converting LaserWriter printers to 220v. The procedures described have to be done in the specific country as international parts are not available for purchase in North America.

This information is also in the Service Source CD; Chapters menu; Additional Procedures; Voltage Conversion.

Be aware that the price of conversion could well exceed the difference of purchasing a completely new product designed for a specific country country.
