Were the Revsision 2.0 ROMs for the LaserWriter IIf and LaserWriter IIg ever put into production LaserWriter printers?

DISCUSSION -----

No. By the time the Revision 2.0 ROMs were available, the LaserWriter IIf and LaserWriter IIg printers were about to be replaced in the product line by a new LaserWriter printer.

Customers who purchased a new LaserWriter IIf or LaserWriter IIg printers and needed the functionality of these new ROMs were eligible for the LaserWriter IIf/IIg ROM Upgrade Kit free of charge from their authorized service provider for a period of time. This free upgrade offer is no longer available, however, customers who need or want the revision 2.0 ROMs can purchase them from their Apple authorized service provider.
