This article describes Likewise version 1.0.1.

Discussion -----

Likewise 1.0.1 has been tested with system 7.1. The ReadMe file includes instructions on how to create a client diskette for Macintosh CPUs that require System 7.1. The package includes two floppy disks:

- 800K disk containing a bootable image for Macintosh systems that can work with System 6.0.8 along with the Admin application.
- 1440K disk containing a bootable image for Macintosh systems that can work with System 7.0.1 along with the Admin application.

Because of disk space constraints, it's impossible to create a universal bootable floppy disk for all the Macintosh systems requiring System 7.1. Also, since this is a release to address bugs and problems with the old release, creating a new floppy disk would imply new features.

There's still no TokenRing support.

Some of the problems addressed in Likewise 1.0.1 are:

- Several problems with Ethernet networks (time-out problems, clients dropping in the middle of transmissions, and so on).
- More than one client booting with the same node ID.
- Problems in networks with a router present.
- · Not deleting all files in the client target disk.
- Not blessing the System Folder created in the client target disk when the Master Folder wasn't part of the boot volume on the Admin station.
