LaserWriter Pro 630: Space Saving Installation (5/93)

TOPIC -----

How do I avoid taking up a lot of space on my hard drive with the LaserWriter Pro 630 software installation? There is no customize option, so it's difficult to see what room there is for maneuvering.

DISCUSSION -----

It is possible to lessen the amount of hard disk space taken up by the LaserWriter Pro software. This can be performed by "drag-copying" the minimum driver software required, as outlined below. Note that the software required is dependent on the version of system software installed on the Macintosh.

System 7 Macintosh

LaserWriter driver 7.2
PrintMonitor 7.1

System 6.x Macintosh

LaserWriter driver 7.2
PrintMonitor 7.0 or 7.0.1 (NOT ON THE LASERWRITER PRO DISKS!!!)
BackGrounder 1.3

NOTE: LaserWriter Prep 7.2 is only required for AppleShare PrintServer 2.0.x.

The other files on the disks, like the TrueType fonts/init, LaserWriter Utility, and Font/DA Mover are optional, based on how the customer will use the printer.
