TOPIC -----

Can I add memory to the empty memory sockets on our LaserWriter Pro 810
4MB Memory Expansion module?

DISCUSSION -----

The LaserWriter Pro 810 can be upgraded using 4 or 8MB (megabyte) memory modules which are available directly from Apple. The 4MB and 8MB memory modules use the same PCB design, but the 8MB module includes eight additional Dynamic RAM (DRAM) memory chips.

Apple does not recommend and will not support upgrading your 4MB memory modules to 8 megabytes. If you still wish to upgrade a 4MB memory module to 8 megabytes, you must add eight 80ns 4MB Zigzag Inline Package (ZIP) DRAM memory chips and remove jumper W1 from the module.
