## LaserWriter Pro 810: W4 and W9 Jumpers (10/94)

TOPIC -----

My LaserWriter Pro 810 I/O controller has two sets of jumpers labeled W4 and W9 each with pins labeled A, B, and C. What are the default positions for the jumpers?

DISCUSSION -----

On the LaserWriter Pro 810 I/O controller board there are two sets of jumpers with A, B, and C configurations. Both jumpers are used by the vendor for printer configurations that include the parallel option. Apple sells the LaserWriter Pro 810 with the Ethernet option instead of the parallel option therefore these jumpers have no effect on the Apple version of this printer.

Although this information isn't valid for the LaserWriter Pro 810 the default positions are as follows:

Jumper W4

-----

A-B jumpered	Centronics Strobe low (default position)
B-C jumpered	Centronics Strobe high

Jumper W9

-----

A-B jumpered	Centronics IPRIME signal enabled
B-C jumpered	Centronics IPRIME signal disabled (default)
