The general rule for RECENTLY discontinued finished goods product is that you may still be able to obtain it by having your local Apple Authorized Service Provider order the manual. If there is still inventory left in the warehouses, the order will be filled. As a last resort, you may want to check to see if it is available as a service part(s).

With regard to the specific manual, M2187LL/A LaserWriter Pro 810 Protocol and Command Reference manual, that manual was discontinued on 1/3/95, so there may still be product in inventory (as of 5/2/95). It is not available as a service part.
