DISCUSSION -----

The power supplies have different Apple part numbers. In addition, the Macintosh IIfx power supply uses a larger fan than the original Macintosh II power supply. The Macintosh IIfx power supply fan is slightly smaller than 3.5 inches in diameter. The original Macintosh II power supply fan is slightly smaller than 3 inches in diameter.
