DISCUSSION -----

The Macintosh Portable had a problem powering on during transit. This was related to some leads on the keyboard that were too long. Thus, when the case flexed, those longer leads caused a direct short to the case, and the system powered on.

The best fix for this problem is to replace the keyboard.
