Macintosh: 1-inch 40MB Drives and Corresponding Carriers

TOPIC -----

One of our dealers has a Macintosh Classic, and the 1-inch Quantum 40MB drive needs to be replaced. They have three replacement 1-inch Conner 40MB drives, all marked part number 661-0464. When they try to mount these drives in the existing carrier, the screw holes don't match.

DISCUSSION -----

It sounds like the Service Provider may not be using the drive carrier originally installed in the Macintosh Classic.

If the Service Provider follows the directions in the Technical Procedures correctly, both the 1-inch Quantum and 1-inch Connor 40MB drives will fit properly in the same drive carrier. However, if you try to install either 1-inch 40MB drive in a carrier designed for a 3.5-inch drive, the screw holes will not align.
