Macintosh 12 RGB Display: Main Board and CRT Compatibility Info

TOPIC -----

This article discusses the compatibility of the Macintosh 12" RGB Display main boards (Rev A and Rev B) and CRTs (Rev A and Rev B).

DISCUSSION -----

Both Rev A and Rev B CRTs will work with either revision (Rev A or Rev B) of the main board, provided the CRT screen voltage is adjusted for the appropriate CRT (refer to the Technical Procedures).

Notes

The High Voltage Probe, available from Apple, is the only probe that should be used to set the screen voltage.

The Rev A and Rev B main boards are not compatible and cannot be interchanged. Replacing the main board with an incorrect revision board is likely to produce incorrect horizontal sync and/or width.

The Technical Procedures contain some inaccurate statements about these issues and are being corrected.
