

## Macintosh SE FDHD Upgrade Kit: Fujitsu ROM Pin 1 ID (9/95)

TOPIC -----

I have a Macintosh SE FDHD Upgrade Kit with a ROM manufactured by Fujitsu. I can't locate pin 1 because the ROM doesn't have any industry-standard pin 1 marking.

DISCUSSION -----

The Fujitsu ROMs have identifying markings to help you locate pin 1. Instead of a small dot or indentation in the ROM housing, a thin line is printed below the vendor and part number information. The line is the full width of the ROM chip.

To identify pin 1, rotate the ROM so that the vendor and part number information can be read easily (see graphic below) and locate the thin line printed horizontally across the ROM. The pin on the far left side of and closest to the line is identified as pin 1. The pin on the far right side is identified as pin 14.
