Macintosh: Front-End Tools to Sybase on HP and SMTP on Sun

TOPIC -----

I want to access Sybase running on an HP 9000 over TCP/IP. I also want to exchange mail with Sun OpenWindows, an SMTP-based e-mail system.

- 1) What front-end tools work with Sybase over TCP/IP? I assume either MacTCP or a DDP-to-IP gateway is required, but what front-end tools can be used with that combination?
- 2) What Macintosh-based e-mail systems interface with an SMTP-based system on Sun?

DISCUSSION -----

- 1) You can use Apple Data Access Language and the query tools like ClearAccess, DataPrism, HyperCard, and so on with DAL Server for HP/UX from Pacer Software.
- 2) Here are the packages we found in the Redgate Macintosh Registry on AppleLink for e-mail gateways that connect leading Macintosh mail systems with systems that support SMTP.
 - Mail*Link SMTP by StarNine Technologies, Inc.
 - Dispatcher by InterCon Systems Corp.
 - cc:Mail Macintosh Platform Pack by cc:Mail
 - GatorMail by Cayman Systems, Inc.

To locate a vendor's address and phone numbers, search with this syntax:

Vendor AND 3rd

where "Vendor" is the vendor's name.
