This article describes what is needed to use the 32-bit System Enabler with the Macintosh II.

DISCUSSION -----

To use the 32-bit System Enabler, a Macintosh II must have:

- a PMMU
- FDHD (SuperDrive) ROMs
- rev B logic board (required for FDHD ROMs)

Customers can obtain a rev B logic board free of charge, under the warranty extensions number OMR1020.

This Repair Extension expired on May 3, 1995.

Customers can obtain an FDHD upgrade kit, service part number M6051-C.

This upgrade has been discontinued.
