What are the recommendations on MacTCP and earlier version of System 6.0.x. I am upgrading my installed base, but I must still run applications on older Macintosh computers. These applications require System 6.0.4 and 6.0.5. What version of MacTCP should I run?

DISCUSSION -----

Any version of MacTCP up to the latest version should work with System 6.0.5 or later. Please note that if you use TCP/IP Connection for the Macintosh, AppleTalk version 58 is required. This can be installed with NSI 1.3 or later.
