

Macintosh 21 Color Display: No Capacitor on Rev B Board (5/94)

TOPIC -----

I am currently working on an Apple 21-in. color display. The display has a revision A main board. Unfortunately the replacement video assembly is Revision B. The Service Source CD has a section on revision compatibility which details a procedure for converting a Revision A main board to revision B. The capacitor necessary to perform this operation is listed as C153 part number 652-0612. This part is not available on Apple Order or in the Service Parts Price Pages. Please give me an alternate part number or specs on the capacitor so that I may purchase it at a local electronics store.

DISCUSSION -----

To change a Rev B main board to a Rev A main board in the 21-in. RGB monitor you do not add a capacitor. Instead, you remove capacitor C153. The removal of C153 is only required when the monitor contains a Rev A CRT.
