

Macintosh LC 475: Not Compatible with Display Enabler 1.0 (5/94)

TOPIC -----

When I connect a Multiple Scan 20 Display to an LC 475 equipped with 512K of VRAM and installed the Display Enabler 1.0 software everything worked fine. When I upgraded the Video Memory to 1 MB, the system stopped working. I get the "Welcome to Macintosh" screen, then the system hangs.

The computer works correctly if I startup with the Extensions disabled. Is this a problem with Display Enabler v1.0?

DISCUSSION -----

This software was designed and tested exclusively for the Centris and Quadra computers and the Apple Multiple Scan displays. There may be, and probably are, bugs when the Display Enabler is used with other pieces of equipment, as you have discovered.

Currently the only workaround is to remove the Display Enabler v 1.0. Apple engineering is currently working on revisions to the software that corrects compatibility problems with other Macintosh computers and displays.
