Multiple Scan 17 Display: Problems with AV Macintosh CPUs (9/94)

TOPIC -----

I have a Multiple Scan Monitor and a Macintosh Quadra 840AV. When I set the monitor so it displays a 19-in. resolution (1024x768), a slight ghosting appears on lines of text and vertical lines on the right side of the screen appear wavy.

DISCUSSION -----

Both these symptoms are only apparent in the 19-in. resolution mode. Because of the many video formats (RS-170, VGA, S-video, RGB, etc.) supported by the 840AV and the numerous resolutions supported by the Multiple Scan 17 and 20 Displays, it is not always possible to obtain a perfect raster under all possible conditions. We consider this to be a very minor problem that does not affect the user's productivity. This is simply a cosmetic flaw that occurs in this configuration.
