TOPIC -----

What is the DIN-8 connector on the back of the Multiple Scan 17 and 20 Display for? Is this a new style video connector? I cannot find anything in the user's manual about this connector.

DISCUSSION -----

The connector is a serial connector. It is used in the manufacturing process to program the geometry, video, and convergence parameters into the microprocessor circuitry on the N-board. However, it also serves another function. It can be used to download the pre-programmed parameters whenever the N-board is replaced by the Service Provider. Full instructions on how this works are included on the Service Source CD.
