TOPIC -----

What are the pinouts for the DB-9 serial loopback plug for the Macintosh 128K and 512K computers?

DISCUSSION -----

The DB-9 serial loopback (part number 077-8129) is part of the diagnostics kit available from Apple. It can also be ordered separately under part number 077-8129

The loopback plug consists of a male DB-9 connector with pins 4 and 8 tied together and 5 and 9 tied together using a small piece of wire-wrap wire.

The pins on the male end of the DB-9 connector are numbered as shown:
